

Minutes
Edenville Township Board Meeting

Tuesday, July 28, 2015, 7:00 p.m.

The meeting was called to order by Supervisor Gosen at 7:00 p.m. and the pledge to the flag was given.

Township Board attendance by roll call was taken; Karen Carey, Bill Carey, Lydia Draves, Craig Gosen, and Galen Gransden were present.

Approval of agenda: All members being present, Gosen moved to add an additional agenda item, new ropes for the flag poles at the Township office. K. Carey seconded and the amended agenda was approved unanimously.

Public Comments: There were no public comments.

Old Business: Status of Harper Park Parking Lot. Gosen reported on the status of the parking lot concerns. He's been in contact with Lapham Engineering and is still in negotiation for a resolution.

New Business:

Gosen motioned to approve Booth Tree Removal to spray for weed control along the South and East fences at Gransden Park. Seconded by K. Carey, there was no discussion and the motion passed unanimously after a roll call vote.

Gosen motioned to approve funds to purchase touch up paint for the play ground equipment at Gransden park and for the hand rails at Harper Park. Seconded by Draves, the motion passed unanimously after a roll call vote.

Gosen motioned to approved funds to purchase new ropes for the flag poles at the Township Office. Seconded by Gransden the motion passed unanimously after a roll call vote.

Gosen updated the board on his tour of private roads in the Township and the status of Campbell Court as regards the Midland County Road Commission. There are a couple of options available going forward with Road Maintenance. Gosen will continue communication with the Road Commission and the residents on a resolution.
